1. Res	pect
	☐ Treat everybody, including fellow campers, counselors, and visitors to Great Hollow, with kindness and respect. This includes respecting other's feelings and differences, avoiding inappropriate language, and keeping your hands to yourself.
	$\square$ Respect nature including all of the animals and plants that call Great Hollow home. Do not touch any wild animal without the expressed permission of a counselor. Do not climb trees or intentionally harm any other plants. Leave the wild in the wild; do not take any plants or animals home.
	$\square$ Respect the property of Great Hollow. This includes all materials provided by camp and structures.
	☐ Be the boss of your body. Nobody gets to make you feel unsafe and you don't get to make anybody else feel unsafe. If someone is behaving in a way that upsets you, ask them to stop. If they continue this behavior, please let a counselor know. If someone is making you feel unsafe at any time, please let a counselor know right away.
	$\square$ Ask for help from a counselor when you have a problem or see others facing an issue

	$\square$ Do not run indoors, on the trails, or the pavement
	$\hfill\square$ Do not use supplied materials in ways other than their intended uses

	$\square$ Campers are responsible for their own personal belongings. All personal belongings should be kept in their designated cubby or, when appropriate, the refrigerator.
	☐ Campers are responsible for cleaning up after themselves. This includes putting away all recreational equipment, arts and craft supplies, disposing of trash in designated bins.
